Dear Parents and Carers

We look forward to welcoming all children back to school on 8th March. Please see separate information that has been sent home with details and timings for return.

As children return, we will be focussing on the children's well-being to acknowledge lock down and the experiences children have had. We will focus on strengths and what children have learnt – both academically and personally. We will give children a chance to share and celebrate with time to talk. We have a team of adults – including our trained ELSAs (emotional literacy support assistants) who are here for the children.

Teachers will be identifying gaps in learning and we will be addressing these by using the Government Covid catch up premium for additional staffing, resources and tutoring sessions. Early indications are that reading comprehension is a priority and so please keep reading and sharing books with your child daily and talk about what you have read. Maths fluency is also key – so keep on with the Times Table Rockstars.

The library will be open in a Covid-safe way on a rota basis when children return. Some of the children currently in school have really enjoyed their visits this week. I would like to say a big THANK YOU to Mrs Smart for providing the home learning reading books over lockdown. This has been a massive task but hopefully has benefited children learning remotely.

Thank you to parents and children for all you have done over this difficult time. Due to your hard efforts and sacrifice, we have not had to have any closures so far at Holly Lodge. Please do remain careful and continue to follow all the risk protection measures.

The sun is shining, spring is on its way and we have a road map back!
